Subject Notice of recommendations for shops, bars and restaurants

NOTICE FROM THE MAYOR'S OFFICE

THE MAYOR AND CHAIR OF CAPDEPERA TOWN COUNCIL HEREBY ANNOUNCES THAT:

With the aim of enhancing the urban environment with a unique attraction and improving the image of our municipality, making it more appealing, captivating and pleasant for visitors and local residents alike, Capdepera Town Council would like to remind all shopkeepers and restaurant owners in the municipality of certain mandatory requirements:

- The dimensions of the exterior of your premises and the terrace must be in keeping with the space available on the premises.
- External signage, posters and other information of interest must be clear and written in one of the two official languages of the Autonomous Community (Catalan and Spanish).
- The licence for the occupation of public space must be respected in accordance with the authorised dimensions.
- The number of outdoor elements within the authorised occupation area must allow easy access to the premises, without obstructing the passage of customers and facilitating access for people with reduced mobility.
- Furthermore, these elements must not obstruct the view of neighbouring businesses or of our own business. Under no circumstances may they impede or obstruct the visibility of traffic

signs, affect the movement of pedestrians and vehicles on the public highway, or pose any danger, particularly to people with reduced mobility.

- If the area to be occupied is already covered by an awning, we recommend that you do not install parasols at the same time. Please bear in mind that our business forms part of the local business community and is not part of a market or fair.
- We would also like to remind you that the use of awnings over public roads, where the supporting structures are building facades or other fixed installations, will be regulated and processed in accordance with the applicable town planning regulations.
- Food products will be subject to the regulations established by the Health Department. It is therefore recommended that they are not kept outside business premises.
- Do not use trees, lampposts, traffic signs or other street furniture to place items.
- As far as possible, during the months when the business is closed, no items may be placed or left that give the impression of abandonment or an image of neglect. Therefore, shutters, planters, display stands and similar items must be completely dismantled, including their fixings.

In view of the above, we appeal to the companies operating within the municipality to follow these recommendations, which in no way undermine the principles of equal treatment and individual freedom, and which aim to respect the image that each business owner wishes to project for their business, in accordance with the criteria they deem appropriate for the benefit of their business.
